### Oklahoma Restaurants by the Numbers ...

#### Sales

In 2010, Oklahoma's restaurants are projected to register \$4.7 billion in sales.

#### Locations

In 2008, there were 5,728 eating and drinking places in Oklahoma.

#### The Power of \$1

Every \$1 spent in Oklahoma's restaurants generates an additional \$1.13 in sales for the state economy.

#### The Power of \$1 Million

Every extra \$1 million spent in Oklahoma's eating and drinking places generates an additional 33.8 jobs in the state.

#### Jobs

Restaurants employ 146,700 people in Oklahoma.

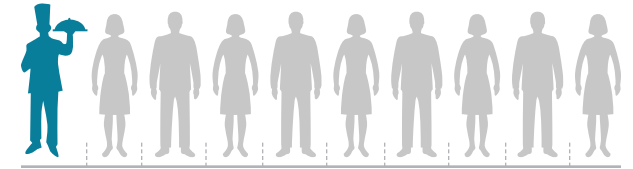
Restaurant jobs represent **9 percent** of employment in Oklahoma.

Almost one in 10 working Americans work in restaurants.



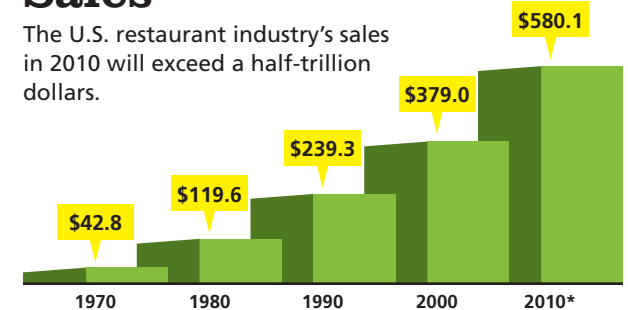
#### The Food Dollar

The U.S. restaurant industry's sales in 2010 will exceed a half-trillion dollars.

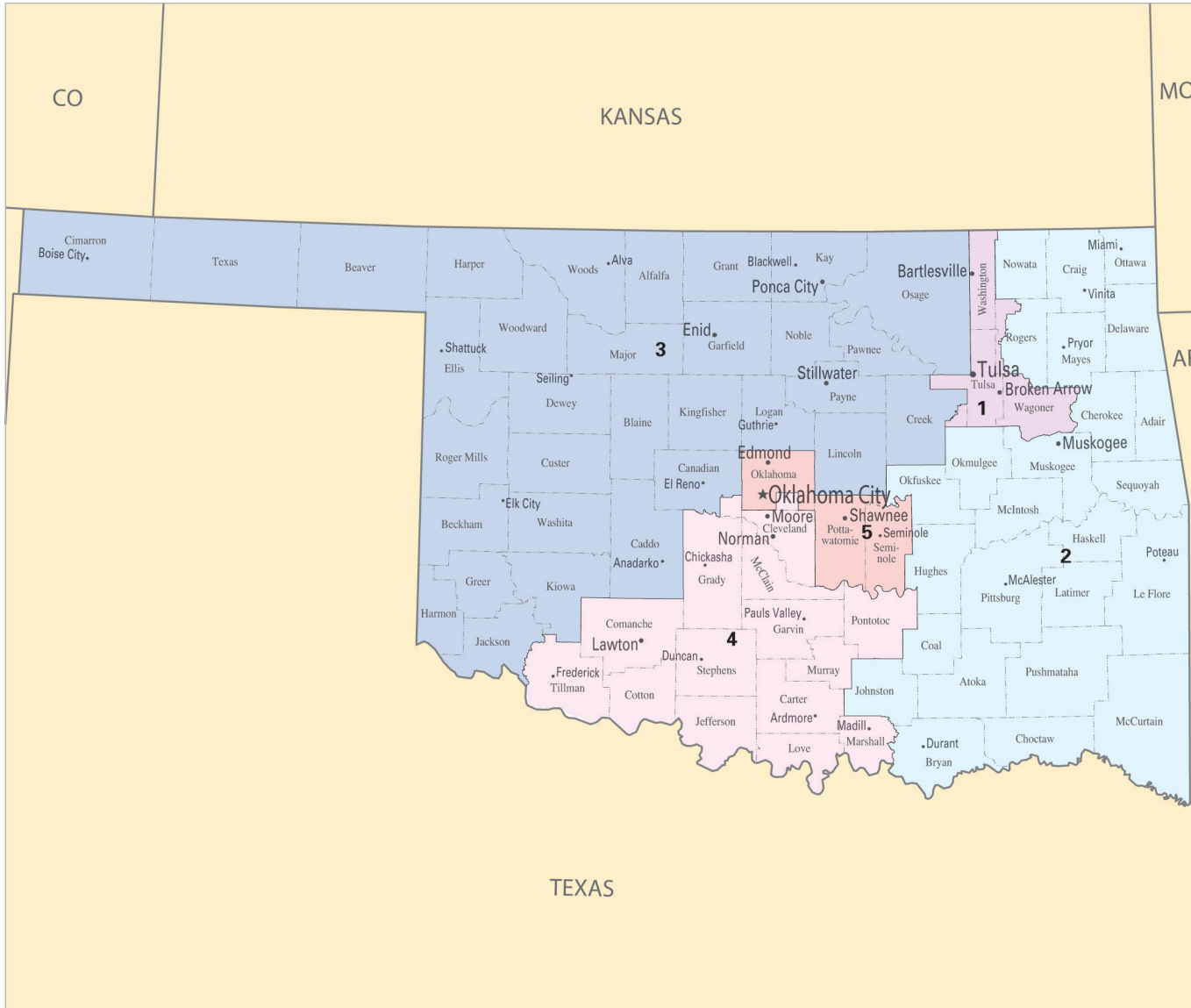
